

Legislative Forum

Pam Emerson has accepted the job of Legislative Correspondent for the newsletter. Each issue Pam will keep us abreast of current topics in state and/or federal legislation. This month's topic is women's health.

This comes from a very reliable source, our National Education Association/MEA/WWEA/LEA; I joined it when I was a delegate to our NEA conventions. Its purpose is to inform US women of US and world women's issues.

Members, please note the paragraph after the 8 items! With our newer higher deductibles for us all, current teachers and retirees, this sounds like I want to check with my doctor's office first just to verify it is regarded as free by them. Also check with your private insurance carrier for verification. If so, then run to get what you need before any new legislature declares it null and void, which the Republicans and Mitch McConnell said they would do as one of their first legislature agenda items after the election.

The following letter was written by Cecile Bendavid, Chair of the NEA Women's Caucus.

The NEA Women's Caucus wants to be certain that you know your new rights as of August 1, 2012.

Women with health plans that start on or after Aug. 1, 2012, must now be allowed access to eight new preventive health services with no co-pays or deductibles. The eight new services available are:

- 1. Well-woman visits
- 2. Gestational diabetes screening
- 3. Domestic and interpersonal violence screening and counseling
- 4. FDA-approved contraception, including contraceptive education and counseling
- 5. Breastfeeding support, supplies, and counseling
- 6. HPV DNA testing for women aged 30 or older
- 7. Counseling for sexually active women about sexually transmitted infections
- 8. HIV screening and counseling for sexually active women.

These services build upon a roster of existing preventive care that the health reform law, officially called the Affordable Care Act (ACA), already makes available, free of cost, to people with private insurance and Medicare, including annual wellness visits, cholesterol, and other cardiovascular screenings, and cancer screenings including mammography, colonoscopy, and screening for cervical cancer.

The eight services were recommended to the Department of Health and Human Services by the independent Institute of Medicine after an extensive scientific review.

Please take advantage of the preventive care available and stay healthy.


