State Executive Board Meeting September 10, 1982 Grand Rapids, Michigan

It was my pleasure to represent all of you at the Executive Board Meeting.

Gamma Alpha's Motion

This was item number 43 on the agenda and 3 hours into the meeting. I must admit we really enlivened the entire assembly. After considerable discussion the motion was narrowly defeated 23 to 21 with 7 abstentions.

Lois Holland then moved that the State President and Executive Secretary investigate the Amway Convention Contract and, if possible to withdraw, choose a new site. Passed 23 to 22 with 2 abstentions. Aftern details were presented by the Convention Committee 2 votes were changed to no, defeating the motion.

When the Convention was contracted Delta Kappa Gamma made a committment for rooms as well as facilities. Therefore, we will need to stay at the Amway to protect the Society's investment. (Delta Kappa Gamma would have to pay for unused rooms.)

Marie Grassa will prepare a letter to the Amway Corporation expressing our wiews. Our Chapter will receive a letter from the State Corresponding Secretary explaining that the Executive Board is in support but at this time a change in location is impossible.

Many no voters were in favor of the motion, but in sympathy with the Convention Committee, which has been planning details for several years.

It is available for purchase (50¢) and our chapter has ordered a copy.
