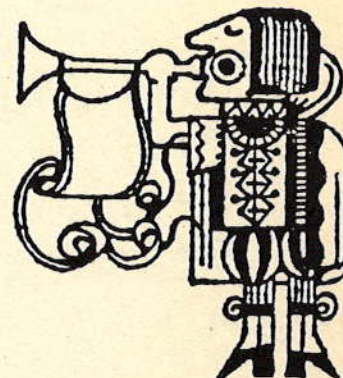

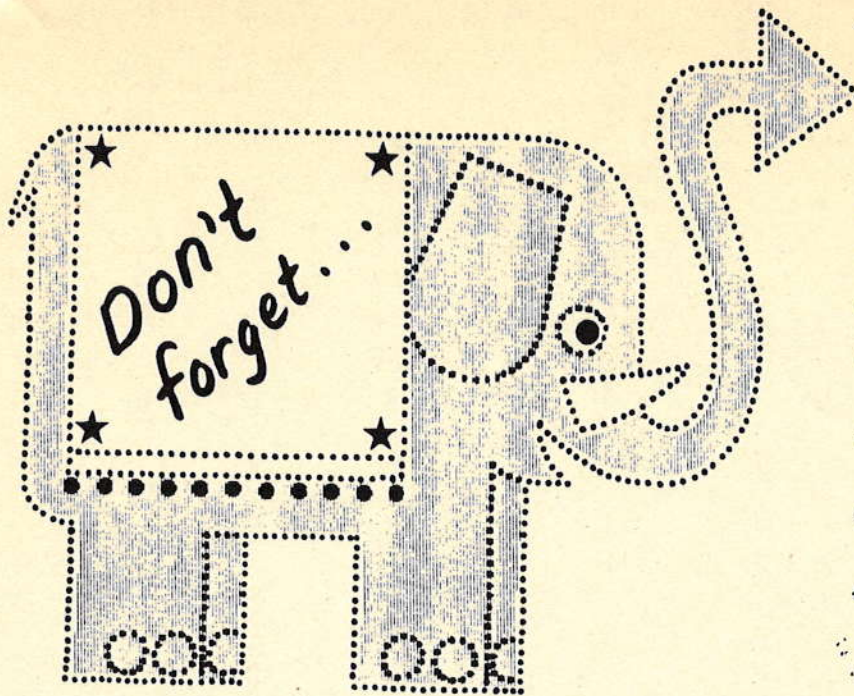
February 5th, 1986

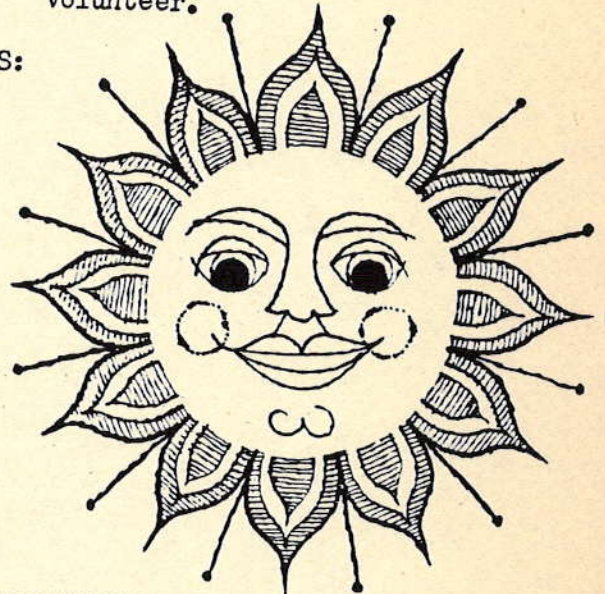

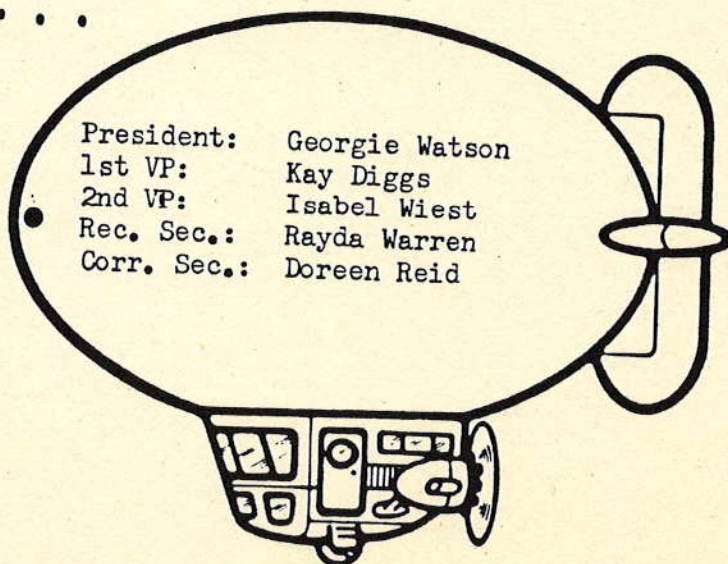
